



**Fatwa No. 8016**

**Q: What is the ruling on the Ruqyah by reciting the Qur'an, Dhikr (Remembrance of Allah), and Du`a' (supplications) narrated from the Prophet (peace be upon him)?**

**A:** It is permissible to recite Ruqyah with Qur'an, Adhkar and Du'a' that were reported by the Prophet (peace be upon him) for the sake of protection and curing what man suffers of illnesses. One can recite Ayat-ul-Kursy (the Qur'anic Verse of the Throne, Surah Al-Baqarah, 2:255), Surah al-Fatihah, (Say, "He is Allah, [who is] One,) and Mu`awwidhatayn (Surahs Al-Falaq and Al-Nas). One can recite the saying of the Prophet (peace be upon him): ﴿ O Lord of the people! Remove the difficulty and bring about healing as You are the Healer. There is no healing but Your Healing, a healing that will leave no ailment. ﴾,

﴿ O Allah! I seek Refuge with Your Perfect Words from every devil and from poisonous pests and from every evil, harmful, envious eye. ﴾and the like.
