The seventh question of Fatwa no. 9688

Q 7: Is it permissible to swear by the Qur'an, or by other than Allah?

A: It is permissible to swear by the Qur'an, because it is the Speech of Allah; and His Speech is one of His Attributes.

(Part No. 1; Page No. 358)

However, it is not permissible to swear by other than Allah, because the Prophet (peace be upon him) said: (Whoever swears by anyone other than Allah has committed Shirk (associating others with Allah in His Divinity or worship).)
