



(4) Entering the toilet while carrying the Mus-haf

From Fatwa no. 2245

Q 2: If one carries the Mus-haf (Qur'an, the Book) in his pocket and enters the toilet while having it in his pocket, what is the ruling regarding this? Please provide us with a useful answer.

All praise be to Allah Alone, and peace and blessings be upon His Messenger, and his family and Companions. To proceed:

A: It is permissible to carry the Mus-haf in the pocket, but it is not permissible to carry it while entering the toilet; rather, one should leave it in an appropriate place, outside the toilet, out of exalting the Book of Allah and honoring it. However, if one must take it with them while entering the toilet, for fear lest it may be stolen if left outside, then due to this necessity, a Muslim is allowed to carry it along while entering the toilet.

May Allah grant us success! May peace and blessings be upon our Prophet Muhammad, his family, and Companions!
