## Miracles & Jamā'ah al-Tablīgh

Yesterday, at Masjid al-Qiblatayn, Shaykh 'Alī bin Yaḥyā al-Ḥaddādī in his lecture narrated:

Once he was sitting with the 'Allāmah, Muḥaddith Shaykh Zayd al-Madkhalī رحمه (d.1436 AH) and a person walked by and Shaykh Zayd Al madkhalī الله رحمه said to Shaykh 'Alī bin Yaḥyā al-Ḥaddādī that this particular man would reject any criticism of Jamā'ah al-Tablīgh , for 16 years.

Until once he found out the reality. That was when he (the man) went out with them and he was in Pakistan. When they were in Pakistan they went to a Masjid. When they arrived at the Masjid they were shown the Storehouse of the Masjid. They said, "this storehouse has no food or anything in it, and we don't ask for any food from it, but Allāh sends the food Himself (a miracle)". This person was in doubt as to what was said. So at night they all went to asleep and he also

pretended that he was asleep. He waited to see what would happen. Then he heard a noise of a car. He quickly got up and went to the storehouse. He saw that there were two or three people getting out of the car and they were unloading sugar and flour into the storehouse. After they unloaded they quickly went away without anybody knowing. Before Fajr when everybody woke up, this group had all come from Makkah and Madīnah. When they saw this they were dazzled and amazed at what happened. They said 'What a miracle from Allah'. A karāmah from Allāh!' . So this person realised that these people were liars. He didnt say anything until after Fajr. He was given an oppurtunity to give a talk. He stood up he said "Listen to me, I bear witness by Allāh that this Karāmah that you are being told is a lie. Its a fabrication. For indeed I was awake before Fajr and I saw these people come in a car and unloaded all the food and now they are decieving you and fooling you, saying that this is a miracle from Allāh."

They tried to beat him and kill him. But Allāh protected him and he escaped from there. This is how this person left Jamā'ah al-Tablīgh.
