The Manner of Performing Salaatul-Eid

Imaam Muhammad ibn Saalih al-'Uthaimeen (May Allaah Have Mercy Upon him)



The First Rak'ah:

- a. Recite Tak-beer al-Ih-raam, i.e. saying: "Allaahu Akbar".
- b. Recite *al-Is-tif-taah* (the opening supplication), saying: "Sub-haana-kAllaa-hum-ma wa Bi-Ham-di-ka, wa ta-baa-ra-kas-muka, wa ta'aalaa Jad-du-ka, wa laa i-laa-ha ghai-ru-ka."
- c. Pronounce six (6) additional *Tak-beers*, raising the hands with each additional *Tak-beer*.
- d. Recite *al-Is-ti-'aa-dhah* (seeking refuge in Allaah from Shaytaan), saying: "A-'oo-dhu bil- laa-his-Samee'il-'Aleem mi-nash-Shay-taanir-Rajeem..." [or other authentic *Is-ti-'aa- dhah*].
- e. Recite *al-Faa-ti-hah* (the Opening Chapter of the Qur'aan).
- F. Recite another chapter from the Qur'aan, like Soorah al-A'-laa (no. 87) or other than that.

The Second Rak'ah

- a. Pronounce five (5) *Tak-beers* not including the *Tak-beer* for standing up from the First Rak'ah – raising the hands with each *Tak-beer*.
- b. Recite *al-Is-ti-'aa-dhah* (seeking refuge in Allaah from Shaytaan), saying: "A-'oo-dhu bi- Ilaahis-Samee'il-'Aleem minash-Shaytaanir-Rajeem..." [or other authentic Is-ti-'aa-dhah].
- c. Recite *al-Faa-ti-hah* (the Opening Chapter of the Qur'aan).
- d. Recite another chapter from the Qur'aan, like Soorah al-Ghaashi'ah (no. 88) or other than that.

Note:

- a. The Eid Salaah is performed **before** the Eid Khut-bah.
- b. There is no A-dhaan (call to prayer) nor 'I-qaa-mah for the Eid Salaah.
- c. There are **no** Sunnah Rak'ah **before** or **after** Salaatul-Eid.
- d. There is no Qadaa' (make-up) for one who has missed Salaatul-Eid. [see: pg. 27-28]
