

Moreover, this treatise of ours-along with many others- has been translated with the permission of the shaykh, may Allah reward well on our behalf.



This is the wisdom behind Allah sending His honorable Messengers and revealing His great books.



And We certainly sent into every nation a messenger saying, 'Worship Allah and avoid the taghut'.¹

And We sent not before you any messenger except that We revealed to him that, 'There is no deity worthy of worship except Me, so worship Me alone.'2

With Tauhid the slave can live a true life full of the good-pleasure of Allah, the Most Merciful, and successfully obtain His generous blessings. But without Tauhid the slave will live a life similar to that of beasts of cattle.



They are only like cattle – nay, they are even farther astray from the path.³

He who doesn't have Tauhid is dead even though he walks on earth. The individual who actualizes and perfects his Tauhid is he who will live a real, true life. Allah, the Sublime and Exalted, says,

Is he who was dead and We gave him life...?1

In other words, We gave him life and revived him with Eman and Tauhid.

He, the Exalted, also says,

O you who believe, respond to Allah and to the Messenger when he calls you to that which gives you life.²

With Tauhid there will be safe security in our countries and relaxation and rest of our bodies.

﴿ اَلَّذِينَ مَامَنُوا وَلَدَ يَلْبِسُوا إِيمَنَهُم بِظُلْمٍ أُولَكِيكَ لَمُمُ ٱلْأَمَنُ وَهُم مُّهَ تَدُونَ ال It is those who believe and mix not their Belief with dhulm [wrong doing and oppression, i.e. shirk] for them there is security and they are guided.³

Allah, the Exalted, also says,

﴿ وَعَدَ اللّهُ الّذِينَ ءَامَنُواْ مِنكُمْ وَعَكِمُلُواْ الصَّلِحَتِ لَيَسْتَخْلِفَنَّهُمْ فِي ٱلْأَرْضِ
كَمَا السَّتَخْلَفَ الَّذِينَ مِن قَبْلِهِمْ وَلَيُمَكِّنَنَّ لَمُمَّ دِينَهُمُ الَّذِب ٱرْتَضَى لَهُمْ
وَلَيُحَبِدِّلَنَهُمْ مِنْ بَعْدِ خَوْفِهِمْ أَمْناً يَعْبُدُونَنِي لَا يُشْرِكُونَ فِي شَيْعًا ﴾

Allaah has promised those among you who believe and do righteous good deeds, that He will certainly grant them succession in the land, as He granted it to those before them, and that He will grant them the authority to practice their religion which He has chosen for them. And He will surely give them in exchange a safe security after their fear provided that they worship Me and do not associate anything with Me."1

With Tauhid you will be happy and at rest. Allah, the Mighty and Majestic, says,

Whoever does righteousness, whether male or female, while he is a Believer- We will surely cause him to live a good life, and We will surely give them their reward according to the best of what they used to do.²

He, the Sublime and Exalted, also says,

And if there should come to you guidance from Me- then whoever follows My guidance will neither go astray nor suffer from misery.

Allah, the Sublime, also says,



We have not sent down to you the Qur'an that you be miserable.²

In other words, We have only sent down to you the Qur'an that you and those who follow you enjoy happiness through the Qur'an.

With Tauhid your heart will be kept far away from all misgiving doubts, evil whispers and bad thoughts.

Through Tauhid the heart will experience its true tranquility, rest and repose. Allah, the Exalted and Sublime, says,

And this is the Tauhid of Allah,

With Tauhid the demons will flee and run away whereas they won't be able to dwell in a place in which Tauhid is strongly and outwardly practiced.


Whenever Shaytan hears the call to the prayer [al-Adhan] he takes off running while breaking wind.

The entire Qur'an expounds on the oneness, glorification and magnification of Allah, the Sublime and Exalted.

Ayatul-Kursi is the verse of Tauhid and a clarification of its conclusive proofs and clear evidences.

Whenever the Believer reads *Ayatul-Kursi* before going to bed there will be a protector for him sent by Allah who will guard him, furthermore, Shaytan won't come near him until He wakes up in the morning.

With Tauheed the slave will be safe –by Allah's permission- from the plot of the evil ones from among magicians and sorcerers.



And incumbent upon us is support of the Believers¹

With Tauhid the slave will obtain all good and happiness in this life and the next, for indeed *Allah*, the Sublime and Exalted, has written in His magnificent pre-ordainment that happiness and bliss will only be for the people of Eman and Tauhid. They will experience this happiness in their lives in the *dunya*, the grave and the Hereafter.



Indeed, the righteous will be in pleasure.2

Tauhid is the very first command to be fulfilled and the greatest obligation that the people should be reminded of.

Allah, the Exalted, says,

And remind, for indeed, the reminder benefits the Believers.

The slave is in need of strengthening his Eman, renewing his Islam and updating his connection with his Lord, the Sublime and Exalted. The Prophet (***) said,

إِنَّ الإِيمانَ لَيَخْلَقُ فِي جَوْفِ أَحَدِكُمْ كَما يَخْلَقُ الثَوْبُ

"Indeed, Eman can be become worn out inside one of you just as a garment becomes worn out."²

In the vast sea of distracting acts of turmoil, torrential desires and stormy trials the people need to be firmly grounded and reassured upon Tauhid. Furthermore, the youth need a very strong upbringing and fortified cultivation upon it.



O my son, do not associate anything with Allah. Indeed associating partners with Him is great wrong.¹

Appendix.

From the speech of Ibn Qayyimil-Jauziyyah regarding the status of Tauhid

Said the genius of Islam, Ibn Qayyimil-Jauziyyah, rahimahullah: "...Rather we will make a decisive statement by saying, every single verse in the Qur'an entails, proves and calls to Tauhid.

For the Qur'an is either information about Allah, His names, attributes and or actions. Thus, this is Tauhid of knowledge and information [i.e. Tauhid of *ar-Rububiyyah* and *al-Asma' was-Sifat*]. Or either a call to worship Him, alone without any partner and do away with everything that is worshipped besides Him, and this is Tauhid of intention and purpose. [i.e. Tauhid of *al-Uluhiyyah*].

Or either a command or prohibition, or a requirement to obey Him in those commands and prohibitions, and this is from the rights and perfection of Tauhid.

Or either information about Allah's kindness and generosity to the people of His Tauhid and obedience, that which He does for them in this world and how He will reward them generously in the Hereafter and this is the reward of His Tauhid.

Or either information about the people of shirk and how He punishes them in this world and the evil recompense that awaits them in the hereafter, hence, this tells us about those who have abandoned Tauhid.

So therefore, the entire Qur'an is about Tauhid, its rights, rewards, and about shirk, its people and their recompense..."
