

Accidentally drinking water while Fasting

Questioner: A fasting person is rinsing his mouth out and accidentally drinks some of the water, what is the ruling on his fast?

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رُحِمَهُ اللهُ)¹: His fast is correct, and in that [mistake of his] is aafiyah [for him]—it is but Allaah who has fed him and given him something to drink.

Questioner: Isn't that about a person who forgot?

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): I know, and what's the difference between someone who forgets ...
