


Ahadeeth regarding particular Aayaat of the Qur'aan

1 – From Aboo Darda (صلى الله عليه وسلم)¹, from the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم)² who said:

'Whoever memorizes the first ten Aayaat from Soorat-ul-Khaaf³ then he is protected from the Fitnah (trials) of the Dajjaal.'

2 – From Aboo Zubayr from Jaabir (رضي الله عنه) from the Prophet (رصلى الله عليه وسلم):

'The Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم) would not sleep till he read: [Alif, Lam, Meem. Tanzeel as-Sajdah] [Soorah Sajda (32)], and [تَبَرَكَ ٱلَّذِي بِيَدِهِ ٱلْمُلْكُ] [Blessed is He in whose hand is dominion] [Soorah Mulk (67)]'

Darimee has a narration from Ibn Damraah from Ka'ab (رضي الله عنه) who said:

'Whoever read Soorah Sajdah and Tabarak, then seventy good deeds are written for him, and seventy bad deeds are taken away, and he is raised seventy grades due to it.'

3 – From Ibn Umar (رضى الله عنه) who said: the Messenger of Allaah (رضى الله عنه) said:

[أَقُنْ نِيَأَتُهَا ٱلْتَغَفِرُونَ] [Say, O disbelievers,] [Soorah Al-Kaafiroon]⁴ is equivalent to a quarter of the Qur'aan.'

4 – From Abdullaah bin Mas'ood (رضي الله عنه) who said: the Messenger of Allaah (رصلى الله عليه وسلم) said:

'Indeed everything has a pinnacle and the pinnacle of the Qur'aan is Soorah Baqarah⁵. When the Shaytaan hears the Qur'aan being recited he leaves the house where Soorah Baqarah is recited.'

5 – From Mua'dh bin al-Juhnee (رضي الله عنه) the Companion of the Messenger of Allaah (رصلى الله عليه وسلم), from the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم) who said:

'Whoever reads [أَفْلُ هُوَ ٱللَّهُ أَحَدً] [Say, 'He is Allaah, [who is] One] [Soorah Ikhlas] until he finishes it ten times then Allaah builds a Palace for him in Paradise as well as additional benefits.'

Umar (رضي الله عنه) said: 'Then we will have a lot of Palaces O Messenger of Allaah!'

The Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said:

'Allaah has more and what is better.'

6 – From Abdullaah bin Shaqeeq from 'Aaishah, the Mother of The Believers (رضتی الله عنها)⁶ who said: 'The Messenger of Allaah (صلی الله علیه وسلم) used to pray four before Dhuhr, two Rakat before 'Asr and he would always pray them. She mentions that he (صلی الله علیه وسلم) would say:

'There are two blessed Soorahs which are read in the two Rakat before the obligatory Fajr prayer. They are [قُلْ هُوَ لَنَّتُ أَحْدً] [Say, 'He is Allaah, [who is] One] [Soorah Ikhlas]⁷ and [قُلْ يُثْيَهَا ٱلْتُعْزُونَ [Say, 'He is Allaah, [who is] One] [Soorah Ikhlas]⁷ and [قُلْ هُوَ لَنَّتُ أَحَدً]

7 – From Aboo al-Ahwass from Abdullaah (رضى الله عنه وسلم) who said: the Messenger of Allaah (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said:

'Read the Qur'aan, since indeed you will be rewarded for it. I do not say that [Alif, Laam, Meem] is one letter, but 'Alif has ten rewards, Laam has ten rewards, and that is thirty rewards.'

8 – From Zurr from Abdullaah (رضى الله عنه) from the Prophet (رصلى الله عليه وسلم):

'Reading Soorah Tabarak⁹ is a means of prevention from the punishment of the grave.'

9 - From Alee (رضي الله عنه), from the Prophet (رصلى الله عنه):

'We have been commanded with using the miswaak¹⁰. Indeed when the slave of Allaah stands to pray an Angel comes to him and stands behind him listening to the recitation of the Qur'aan and then he comes closer. The Angel continues to listen and come closer until it puts its lips on his lips, and he does not recite an Aayah except that it enters inside the Angel.'

10 – From Malik al-Ashja'ee from his father (رضي الله عنه) who said: the Messenger of Allaah (رصلى الله عليه وسلم) said:

'Whoever teaches an Aayah¹¹ from the Book of Allaah (عزرجل)¹² then he will have the reward of that every time it is recited.'

11 – From Abool-Ahwass from Abdullaah (رضي الله عنه) who said: the Messenger of Allaah (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said:

'Read Soorah al-Baqarah¹³ in your houses, indeed the Shaytaan does not enter a house in which Soorah al-Baqarah is read.'
