

## Amount of rain that falls every year is the same

From Ibn Abbaas (رضي الله عنه) who said, "'No year has more rain than another, but Allaah distributes it between His Creation wherever He wishes.' Then he recited, "And We have distributed it amongst them, in order that they may remember [the Grace of Allaah] ...""

Shaykh al-Albaanee  $(i)^3$  said, "So it is apparent from what has preceded that even if the hadeeth is mawquf<sup>4</sup> it has the ruling of being marfoo<sup>5</sup> – because such a thing cannot be said based upon opinion and ijtihaad, and because it has been reported in marfoo form [in another narration]."
