بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

**Questioner:** Ustaadh, a man enters the mosque while the mu'addhin is giving the adhaan, does he pray the tahayyatul-masjid or stand in order to repeat what the mu'addhin says?

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ): I think your question is wanting, it is a general question, I think you mean on Fridays?

**Questioner:** No, in general, O Ustaadh.

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ): That's easier [then], it's easier if you mean in general.

**Questioner:** Yes.

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ): No, he answers the mu'addhin [i.e., repeats after him], and then afterwards reads the tahayyatul-masjid.<sup>1</sup>
