From Anas, (rad iyallaahu `anhu)¹ "When he (صلى الله عليه وسلم) would strive in supplicating for someone he would say:

جَعَلَ اللهُ عَلَيْكُمْ صَلاةً قَوْمٍ أَبْرَار، يَقُوْمُوْنَ الْلَيْلَ وَيَصُوْمُوْنَ الْنَهَار، لَيْسُوْا بِأَتْمَةٍ وَلا فُجَّار

Jaʻalallāhu ʻalaikum şalāta qowmin abrār, yaqūmūnal-laila wa yaşūmūna-nahāra laisū bi athamatin wa lā fujjār

'May Allaah cause to be over you the prayers of a righteous people who stand [in prayer] at night and fast during the day, and who are neither sinners nor wicked evil-doers.''³
