

## Jinn questions 1

**Questioner:** Is it possible for a person to see his jinn?

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ)<sup>1</sup>: No, it is not possible.<sup>2</sup>

**Questioner:** Everyone has a [jinn] companion [Qareen], is it possible for the Qareen to become visible to the eye [whether in their] true form or another?

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ): Allaah knows best. It is possible that the jinn can manifest itself in different forms, this is something unequivocal. As for the question [specifically] about the Qareen [assigned to every individual] then I don't have an answer, since nothing has been reported to us in this regard.

**Questioner:** Is it true or [just something] imaginary that after a person is murdered it [i.e., his Qareen] becomes visible?

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ): No, this is a myth.<sup>3</sup>

**Questioner:** Is it correct that we will see the Jinn on the Day of Resurrection but they will not see us, i.e., the opposite of how it is in the Duniya?

**Shaykh al-Albaanee** (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ): That is not correct.<sup>4</sup>
