Shaykh al-Albaanee (rahimahullaah) (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ)¹ said:

‘So O you Muslim, it is obligatory upon you, an individual obligation that you hasten to know and acquaint yourself with the pure Tawheed, and what nullifies it from Shirk. That is done by studying the Book of Allaah and the Sunnah of His Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم)².

Indeed whoever adheres to them will be successful, and whoever deviates away from it, becomes misguided. Allaah’s help is sought.’³
