

## (صلى الله عليه وسلم), Sending prayers upon the Prophet

Ammaar bin Yaasir (rad iyallaahu `anhu) said, "Allaah's Messenger (صلى الله عليه وسلم) said:

'Indeed Allaah has assigned an angel to my grave, He has given him the names of [all] creation. So no-one sends prayers upon me until the Day of Judgment except that he informs me of that person's name and his father's name, [saying]: 'This is so and so the son of so and so, he has sent prayers upon you.""<sup>3</sup>

Note: Sending prayers on the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم) is when a person says *sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam* (May the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) after mentioning the Prophet (صلى الله عليه ).

Reported by Al-Bazzaar and others, and our Shaykh Al-Albaanee, may Allaah have mercy on him, declared it hasan in Saheeh al-Targheeb wat-Tarheeb (1667) and also refer to Al-Saheehah (1350).
