When my sutrah goes what should I do?

بسم الله الرحمن الرحيم

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

Host: There's a question here [which says], 'When my sutrah¹ goes what should I do?' He means when the sutrah is something which can move or be carried and it is taken.

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)²: In such a situation if it is possible for him to go towards a sutrah through a slight [amount of] movement he does so, if he can't then Allaah does not burden a soul with more than it can bear, for example, if there were a pillar there or a person who is sitting down, he can approach it or him with a step or two and use it or him as a sutrah.
