Blind-following

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

Shaykh Muqbil ibn Haadee al-Waadi'ee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)¹ said, "And we say: we hold blind-following to be forbidden. So it is not allowed for us to blindly follow Shaykh al-Albaanee, nor Shaykh Ibn Baaz nor Shaykh Ibn 'Uthaymeen, for indeed Allaah (رتعالي)² says in His Noble Book, ["Follow, [O mankind], what has been revealed to you from your Lord and do not follow other than Him any allies. Little do you remember,"]³ and He (سبحانه وتعالى)⁴ said, ["And do not pursue that of which you have no knowledge."]⁵ So Ahlus-Sunnah do not blindly follow."
