
The conditions for an action to be correct – condition 5

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

With regards to the conditions for an action to be correct, the Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al 'Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)¹ states:

Fifthly – that the action conform with the Sharee'ah in zamaan (time); so if he prayed the prayer before the beginning of its time, then his prayer is not accepted because it was in a time other than that demarcated by the Legislation.

And if he performed the Adhaa sacrifice before he prayed the 'Eed prayer then it would not be accepted because it did not conform to the Legislation in zamaan.
