
Gathering together for reciting the Qur'aan

Question: Is it permissible to gather together for the purpose of reciting the Qur'aan, whether it is done occasionally or everyday?

Answer: Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ)¹: If there is no intent for this gathering other than to make it easy for Muslims, who desire to study the Qur'aan, to meet together, then there is nothing wrong with this. But if this type of gathering is scheduled with the intention of performing worship to Allaah and to try to please Him, in itself, then it is not permissible.
