
A reduction in the implementation of the testimony that Muhammad rasool ullaah

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بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

With regards to a person putting into practice his testimony (that Muhammad (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ)¹ is the Messenger of Allaah) and how the person might fall short in doing that, Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al ‘Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)² states:

As for that which reduces the implementation of this testimony, then it is:

1) Carrying out an act of disobedience.

So the act of disobedience causes a reduction in the implementation of this testimony because through your act of disobedience, you have departed from following the Prophet (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ).

2) Innovating in the religion that which is not from it.

This is because you have sought to draw close to Allaah with that which neither Allaah nor His Messenger (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) legislated. So innovating in the religion is, in reality, an act of mocking Allaah because you have sought to draw close to Him with something which He did not legislate.
