Question: Is it permissible to burn books, newspapers and publications containing Qur'aanic verses or prophetic hadeeths?

Shaykh Aboo `Abd-al-Mu`iz `Alee Ferkous al-Qoobee (May Allaah the Most High preserve him): All praise is due to Allaah, the Lord of the Worlds. Peace and blessing be upon whom Allaah sent as a mercy to the Worlds, upon his Family, his Companions and his Brothers till the Day of Resurrection.

It is permissible to burn books, newspapers and publications that contain Qur'aanic verses or prophetic hadeeths, since the Companions رضي الله عنهم burnt all the copies of the Qur'aan that were different from that of `Uthmaan رضي الله عنه, though they contained Qur'aanic verses.

The perfect knowledge belongs to Allaah عزَّ وجلَّ. Our last prayer is all praise is due to Allaah, the Lord of the Worlds. Peace and blessing be upon our Prophet صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ, his Family, his Companions and Brothers till the Day of Resurrection.
