**Questioner:** “Shaykh Ahmad an-Najmee? HayakAllaah.”

**Shaykh:** “No. The one who leaves off all actions is a disbeliever. And if he says that he is a Muslim, then he is liar. He cannot be a Muslim unless he performs actions.”

**Shaykh:** “And you to.”

**Questioner:** “As salamu ‘alaykum wa rahmatullah.”
