With regards to the second type of sabr, Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al ‘Uthaymeen (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ)¹ states:

The second: patience upon obedience to Allaah, in that the person holds back his soul upon obedience – such as a man who wishes to pray, but his soul calls him towards laziness and to (lying down in) bed and towards food which he has no need of, or to chatting with the brothers. But he forces himself into standing for the prayer.

So this is sabr upon obedience to Allaah.
