Validity of divorcing a pregnant woman

Q 2: If a Muslim divorces his wife during her pregnancy, is this divorce valid or not?

When a husband steals his wife's jewelry, does she have the right to ask him to return it?

A: Firstly: Divorcing a pregnant woman is valid and effective. Her `Iddah (woman's prescribed waiting period after divorce or widowhood) ends when she delivers.

Secondly: If a husband steals his wife's jewelry, she has the right to claim it back, if it is hers or she has borrowed it. However, if the jewelry is the husband's possession or he has borrowed it for his wife, she has no right to demand it.
