DUA FOR PARENTS

Allah has commanded us to treat our parents well in many places in His Book. One of those places is Surah Luqman, where Allah says,

And We have commanded people to 'honour' their parents. Their mothers bore them through hardship upon hardship, and their weaning takes two years. So be grateful to Me and your parents. To Me is the final return. (Surah Lugman 31:14).

We should ask for forgiveness for them, pray for their guidance, seek their forgiveness when we have wronged them or when they have wronged us, make du'aa' for them regularly during their life and after their death.

We should also fulfill all of their needs during their lifetime even if it means sacrificing something important to us.

Your parents played an integral role in helping you become the person you are today, so it's important to show them that you care.

One way to do this is through prayer and good deeds, which your parents will definitely appreciate.

Supplicating for your parents can help you start thinking about showing your appreciation of your parents every day and serve as a reminder of all they have done for you.

Dua is a simple way to remind yourself of how important your parents are to you in your daily life.

After being obedient to Allah and the Messenger of Allah, a Muslim must be obedient to his/her parents.

respect for our parents is such that it requires many things including the following:

- That we keep them out of harm's way;
- That we treat them with kindness:
- That we do not get irritated with them or with their needs;
- That we regard service to them as an act of worship;
- That we pray to Allah to forgive them and have mercy on them;
- That we do not raise our voice above theirs;
- That we do not go against their wishes, as long as this does not entail any violation of Allah's Commands;
- If our temper should even flare up in anger towards them, we must remember how they brought us up, how they spent many sleepless nights doing so, how they cared for us and wore themselves out.

1.Dua For Parents

رَّبِّ ارْحَمْهُمَا كَمَا رَبَّيَانِي صَغِيرًا

Rabbi irhamhuma kama rabbayanee sagheera

My Lord! Be merciful to them as they raised me when I was young.

Dua For Forgiveness For Parents 1

Rabbana-ghfirli wa liwalidayya wa lilmu'minina yauma yaqumul-hisab

Our Lord! Forgive me, my parents, and the believers on the Day when the judgment will come to pass.

Dua For Forgiveness For Parents 2

Rabbi ighfir lee waliwalidayya waliman dakhala baytiya mu'minan walilmu'mineena walmu'minati wala tazidi ththalimeena illatabara

My Lord, forgive me and my parents and whoever enters my house a believer and the believing men and believing women. And do not increase the wrongdoers except in destruction.

4. Dua To Increase Blessings On Parents

Rabbi awzi'nee an ashkura ni'matakallatee an amta alayya wa alaa waalidayya wa an aamala saalihan tarzahu, wa aslih lee fee zurriyyatee innee tubtu ilayka wa inni minal muslimeen

My Lord, enable me to be grateful for Your favor which You have bestowed upon me and upon my parents and to work righteousness of which You will approve and make righteous for me my offspring. Indeed, I have repented to You, and indeed, I am of the Muslims.

5. Dua for parents health and long life

There is no specific supplication for parents health and long in the Qur'an and Sunnah. You can ask Allah with your own words, you can read this also:

Oh Allah, prolong the life of my mother and father, grant them health as long, and make their hearts happy, and relieve them of all and ease their affairs

6. Dua For Parent Who Passed Away

O Allah! forgive him, have mercy upon him, give him peace and absolve him. Receive him with honour and make his grave spacious; wash him with water, snow and hail. Cleanse him from faults as You wouldst cleanse a white garment from impurity. Requite him with an abode more excellent than his abode, with a family better than his family, and with a mate better than his mate. Admit him to the Garden, and protect him from the torment of the grave and the torment of the Fire. Sahih Muslim, 963

7. Dua For Parent After Death

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّ فُلاَنَ بْنَ فُلاَنٍ فِي ذِمَّتِكَ فَقِهِ فِتْنَةَ الْقَبْرِ. فِي ذِمَّتِكَ وَحَبْلِ جِوَارِكَ فَقِهِ مِنْ فِتْنَةِ الْقَبْرِ . وَعَذَابِ النَّارِ وَأَنْتَ أَهْلُ الْوَفَاءِ وَالْحَمْدِ اللَّهُمَّ فَاغْفِرْ لَهُ وَارْحَمْهُ إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْغَفُورُ الرَّحِيمُ

O Allah, so and so, son of so and so, is in Your protection, so guard him from the trial in the grave. In Your protection and in Your nearer presence, so guard him from the trial in the grave) and the punishment in Hell. You are faithful and worthy of praise. O Allah, forgive him and show him mercy. You are the forgiving and the merciful one.

Although, this Dua is not specifically for the parents, there is no harm in doing it. Sunan Abi Dawud, 3202

If one of them or both of them attain old age in your life, say notto them a word of disrespect. (Surah al-Israa: 23)

Abu Huraira reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Verily, Allah Almighty will raise the status of his righteous servants in Paradise and they will say: O Lord, what is this? Allah will say: This is due to your child seeking forgiveness for you."
