Guidance of the Prophet (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) Concerning The Eid Day Al-'Allaamah Ibn Qayyim al-Jawziyyah (May Allaah Have Mercy Upon him)

- 1. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) used to always perform the two *Eid* prayers in the *Musallaa* (outside prayer grounds). He only performed this *Salaah* in the Masjid one time, due to rain.
- 2. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) used to wear his **best clothing** when he went out for the two *Eid* prayers.
- 3. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) used to eat an **odd number of dates** before going out for the *Eid al-Fitr* (prayer). As for the *Eid al-Adhaa* (prayer), he would not eat until he returned from the *Musallaa* (outside prayer grounds), in which case he would eat from the *Ad-heeyah* (sacrificed animal).
- 4. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) used to take a *Ghusl* (complete bath) for both of the *Eids*.
- 5. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) used to go out to the two *Eid* prayers walking.
- 6. Whenever he (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) reached the *Musallaa* (outside prayer grounds) he would begin with the *Salaah* without *A-dhaan* and without '*Iqaamah*, and without saying "as-Salaatu Jaami'atan" (i.e. "Salaah, in Congregation").
- 7. Whenever he (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) finished the *Salaah*, he would **stand** facing the people while the people would be sitting. Then, he would deliver the **religious advice and exhortation**; and he would begin the *Khut-bah* with 'Praise of Allaah'.
- 8. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) gave *permission* to those who attended the *Eid* prayer to either **sit** for the *Khut-bah* or **leave**.
- 9. He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) used to **go** (to the place of prayer) by one road and **return** by another road.
