The Night Prayer of the Prophet (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) In Ramadaan

We were fasting with the Messenger of Allaah (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallaam) in Ramadaan.

So, he did not lead us (in prayer) until only 7 (nights remained) from the month; so he lead us in prayer for one third of the night.

Then he did not lead us in prayer on the 6th night, but he lead us in prayer on the 5th night, for half of the night.

I said: O Messenger of Allaah, if only you led us in voluntary prayer for the remainder of this night of ours.

He (SallAllaahu Alaihi wa Sallam) said:

"Whoever stands in prayer with the Imaam until he finishes, Allah will record for him standing for the whole night".

Then, he did not lead us in prayer and he did not perform Qiyaam until three nights remained from the month.

Then, he lead us when only 3 nights remained, and he gathered his family and his wives (praying)

until we feared that we would miss al-Falaah.

I said: and what is al-Falaah. He (the narrator) said: as-Sahoor (the pre-dawn meal)
